**PANUI No. 3:
APRIL 2004 ACE ROUND
(for Fishing Years Commencing
1 February and 1 April 2004)**

1. INTRODUCTION

This Panui relates to the ACE round for the fishing years commencing on 1 February and 1 April 2004, called the April 2004 ACE round. The round was initiated by the Commission in Panui No.1 dated 30 January 2004. The subsequent Panui No. 2 dated 18 March 2004 provided some additional information.

Some of the data, particularly decisions of the Minister of Fisheries, required to operate the ACE round were not available at the time Panui No.1 and Panui No. 2 were issued. Those decisions have since been announced and the final April 2004 ACE round figures are included in this Panui.

PART II: PARTICIPATION

2. COMPLIANCE WITH ACE ROUND REQUIREMENTS

Te Ohu Kai Moana is nearing a position to make offers of ACE shares to those Iwi who have:

- Complied with all the prerequisites for participation in the April 2004 ACE round; and
- Have agreed their respective shares of the ACE available to the FMA(s) in which they have rohe.

Appendix 1 summarises the position for all Iwi in relation to the participation requirements. Missing data is highlighted.

3. IWI SHARES

Panui No.1 required management area representatives to decide, and to notify Te Ohu Kai Moana **by 19 March 2004**, Iwi shares of ACE available in management areas. Section 4 of Panui No. 2 set out the Iwi share decisions to be made by management area representatives

and the information representatives needed to provide to Te Ohu Kai Moana. Those details are repeated below.

To assist representatives in calculating lwi shares, the following table shows that there are six types of share decisions for lwi in the April 2004 ACE Round –

Advices on lwi shares from management area representatives need to clearly specify the treatment of each of the applicable categories of ACE listed above. Any that do not do so will be returned to the representatives for correction and will delay ACE distributions. Representatives are reminded that lwi share notifications are due at Te Ohu Kai Moana are now overdue and are to be provide urgently.

This level of detail is needed in responses on shares because of the changed methodology being used in the April 2004 ACE round and the large number of new stocks entering the QMS on 1 April 2004. From the responses and questions received from management area representatives it is obvious the calculation of lwi shares has been quite difficult.

Appendix 2 to this Panui shows the information on lwi shares received by Te Ohu Kai Moana to date. To assist Management Area representatives in their deliberations for the April 2004 ACE Round, the Appendix has been divided into four Parts – Part (a) deals with rock lobster fisheries, Part (b) with scallop fisheries, Part (c) with the FMA6 southern blue whiting fisheries and Part (d) with the new fishstocks entering the QMS from 1 April 2004.

Parts (a), (b) and (c) show the shares agreed for the April 2003 ACE Round and the information provided to date for the April 2004 ACE Round. Part (d) shows only the information provided for the April 2004 ACE Round.

4. IWI SHARES AND POPULATION

Iwi are reminded that Te Ohu Kai Moana has allotted *Deepwater* ACE to FMAs using the following formula:

- 25% by coastline measure;
- 75% by Iwi affiliations as recorded in the 2001 Census and as applied for the October 2003 ACE round;

This **does not** automatically mean that the 2001 Census affiliations must be used for the calculation of Iwi ACE shares within an FMA. That is a decision of the FMA representatives.

FMA representatives need to agree:

- whether to apply the previous 50% coastline/50% population or the new 25% coastline/75% population splits in calculating Iwi shares of *Deepwater* ACE; and
- whether to use the 1996 or the 2001 Census Iwi affiliation numbers in “population” calculations – for *Deepwater* and *Deepwater FMA6 only* stocks.

The decisions reached need to be conveyed to Te Ohu Kai Moana so that accurate Iwi share calculations can be made. To assist FMA representatives in reaching their decisions Appendix 3 to this Panui shows the 1996 Census and 2001 Census Iwi affiliation figures by FMA.

Actions Required:

- (a) **Decisions on Iwi shares of available ACE under the April 2004 ACE round are overdue. Please provide them urgently.**
- (b) **Management Area representatives are asked to verify their April 2004 Ace Round share information.**

PART III: ACE ROUND OPERATIONAL ITEMS

5. SUSTAINABILITY and MANAGEMENT DECISIONS

The Minister of Fisheries has now made all his management and sustainability decisions for the fishing years covered by the April 2004 ACE round. His decisions for new species and fishstocks entering the QMS on 1 April 2004 were included as Appendix 1 of Panui No.1. They are again shown in this Panui in Appendix 4. His latest decisions, published in the *NZ Gazette* on 22 March 2004, relate to existing QMS fishstocks.

They are –

Rock lobster (CRA7) – TAC increased from 109.000mt to 114.886mt. TACC increased from 89.000mt to 94.886mt;

Rock lobster (CRA8) – TAC increased from 655.000mt to 690.370mt. TACC increased from 568.000mt to 603.370mt.

No TAC or TACC change for any other existing fishstocks covered by the April 2004 ACE round.

The Minister has supported the “shelving”, that is not fishing, of 37.50% of CRA3 ACE for the 2004/05 year.

Appendix 4 to this Panui shows the final quantities of ACE held by Te Ohu Kai Moana available for distribution under the April 2004 ACE round.

6. LEVIES and CHARGES

Final Crown levy rates for the period commencing 1 April 2004, were published in the *NZ Gazette* on 22 March 2004. The new levies have been incorporated into the 2004/05 ACE Sale Charges in Appendix 4 of this Panui. These levy rates include application of the settlement of the longstanding Crown levies “over and under-recoveries” dispute enacted in March 2004 which has resulted in lower than normal Crown levies.
