- Template Deeds for MIOs & Constitutions for AHCS
- Template ACE Sales Contracts for AHCs
- ACE harvest conditions (to attach to ACE sales contracts)
- Valuation of Quota shares and AFL shares
- Assistance to ‘prove’ developmental fisheries

Possible further topics

Assistance with:

- Obligations under MFA 2004 & Fisheries Act 1996 as governors and managers eg optimal structural arrangements for JVs etc, strategic governance, calendar of events/requirements
- Fisheries management plans particularly fisheries management strategies for customary commercial and non-commercial fisheries interests so that both are mutually supportive at regional level
- Implementation of policy that may impact significantly on region eg MPA strategy
